

## Music Camp Notes

### Basic Schedule:

- Due to construction, check ArcadiaMusic.org website for any last minute changes in exact location for departure and return.
- On Friday, August 20<sup>th</sup> take luggage and instrument to AHS Faculty Lot (NE corner of El Monte and Duarte ) between 7:30 and 8:30 a.m. to be loaded on trucks.
- Return by 10:00 with lunch and water bottle and **check in**. Drop off in parking lot on NE corner of El Monte and Duarte.

Do NOT bring a lot of money or valuables. **Rooms do NOT lock.**

The only places to spend money are at the camp store with a limited inventory—toothpaste and such—and at the afternoon snack bar. Bikes can be rented for \$5 an hour. You ride only on the trails/roads inside the camp. If you plan on buying soft drinks from the machines, bring dollar bills or quarters.

Remember, bring a water bottle, refill it; drink lots of water!
