## *Welcome & Introductions*

February 16, 2010 Arcadia Music Club General Meeting opened by President Larry Pang at 7:06 PM. Modify Meeting minutes from Jan. 19, 2010 under nominating meeting month add "Tuesday February 9, 2010", otherwise accepted as written.

## *Old Business*

- 1) Financial Report – (Rose Meyer) There is a \$152K balance in the music club checking account. Total income of \$336K with \$328K expenses net income is \$8K. Bulk of income is from spaghetti dinner; expenses include payments made for color guard trip, spaghetti dinner, and band/color-guard instruction. Additional income money expected to come in from spaghetti dinner and AFOB.
- 2) Larry Pang, a donation of \$250 approved by the music club executive board to provide additional copy paper for music program directors use. A matching fund donation received for music programs use from British Petroleum for \$500 on behalf of John Tsouvalas.

## *Committee Reports*

- 1) Orchestra Benefit Dinner – (Linda Chan) Ticket sales are similar to last year, benefactors down a bit. Planning meeting tonight after general the meeting. It is not too late to buy tickets to the benefit dinner.
- 2) Pop Concert – (Maria Diaz) – Tracy Tierney will help co-chair the event.
- 3) Nomination Committee (Larry Pang) – Nomination committee met last week to come up with a slate of board members and committee members to volunteer positions for next year.
