REHEARSAL INFORMATION

- We will practice the “TV Corner” turn and put in some miles. Time will also be spent reviewing the Field Show.
- Wear your band shows and two pairs of socks. Heel blisters are no fun!
- Drink water the night before to hydrate your body.
- Trim those toe nails.
- Don’t over dress. Your body will warm up quickly once we start marching and you don’t want to over heat.

ROSE PARADE INFORMATION

- We will play non-stop from the beginning of the parade, through “TV Corner” turn until we get to the end of the TV area. That includes playing while we make the turn.
- Wear your band shows and two pairs of socks. Heel blisters are no fun!
- Drink water the night before to hydrate your body.
- Trim those toe nails.
- It will be cold early, but will get warmer as we march. **Don’t over dress under your uniform.** Your body will warm up quickly once we start marching and you don’t want to over heat.
- Colorguard and banner, you might think about wearing an old pair of sweats the you would not mind discarding as we prepare to march the parade.
- Smaller instruments will be carried on the bus out of their cases. Larger instruments will be uncased in the trailer, ready to grab and go. At the end of the parade we will case up all the instruments.
- Everyone will get In-N-Out at the end of the parade.
- Being early in the parade we should get good TV coverage. The local stations and HGTV usually have the least number of commercials.
